Herewith are the general instructions and agreements:

• Bureaus/sectors to ensure the alignment of their priority policies with the thrust and directions of the Secretary;

- Bureaus/sectors to brief their Supervising Undersecretary on their priority policy agenda prior to presentation to the Secretary and submission of updated list to the Policy and Planning Service (PPS);
- Bureaus/sectors to ensure that the timeline for the endorsement of the priority policy is realistic;
- Proposed operational policies should be coordinated/consulted with the Undersecretaries for Field Operations;
- For the PPS and the Bureaus/sectors to further study and discuss the appropriateness of issuance of Technical Bulletins (TBs). If the release of TBs is warranted, such issuances should be aligned with the main policy and should be limited to the technical aspects of the policy. Further, the proposed TBs should be cleared with the Central Office; and
- Proposed Executive Orders (EOs) to be directly endorsed to/and vetted by the Undersecretaries, provided that these have undergone completed staff work (CSW) and concurrence by relevant agencies
