- 3. CSC proposed to enter to a memorandum of agreement/understanding (MOA/MOU) through its Regional Offices with their DENR regional counterparts to formalize the partnership:
- 4. The DENR and CSC shall hold a simultaneous online MOA or MOU signing to between respective Regional Directors.

The DENR-NCR committed to the CSC-NCR to facilitate the preparation of the MOA between the CSC-NCR and DENR-NCR, and to allocate sites for the CSC-NCR and CSC Central Office personnel to participate for the ICC.

However, to cascade the proposed partnership to other Regional Offices, we respectfully request for the Undersecretaries for Field Operations issue guidance to the Regional Offices to coordinate with their respective CSC counterparts regarding this partnership.

Also, we respectfully request for the Strategic Communications and Initiatives Service to coordinate and lead the simultaneous online MOA/MOU signing event across the Region Offices.
