This has reference to the DENR Trade Focal Group Meeting No. 2024-05 held last 21 August 2024, via Zoom videoconferencing. The meeting was attended by the Trade Focal Group Members of the DENR Offices and Bureaus. In this regard, hereunder are the highlights of the meeting with corresponding action taken and next steps per agenda items:

dated 27 August 2024, PPS-PSD endorsed the inputs/comments manifested by the DENR representatives during the inter-departmental meeting to the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI). Enclosed is the said letter for reference.

ASEAN - China Free Trade Agreement (ACFTA)

The PPS discussed the updates on the ACFTA, particularly on the two chapters:

Green Economy

- The negotiation for the Chapter Green on **Economy under the ACFTA** has been substantially concluded during the 8th Round of the **Joint** Committee Meeting, along with all the Working Groups (WG), held in Ha Long, Viet Nam on 05-09 August 2024.
- The Working Group on Legal and Institutional Issues (WGLII) has agreed not to develop horizontal provisions (e.g. exceptions, transparency, cross-cutting definitions) for the ACFTA 3.0 Upgrade. In this regard, they recommend for the working groups to negotiate these provisions if they deem necessary to be included in their respective chapter.
- Given that the Green Economy Chapter has included 3 of the horizontal provisions (Chapterspecific definitions, Contact Points, and Chapter-

ASEAN - Canada Free Trade Agreement (ACAFTA)

PPS briefly discussed the updates on the proposed ASEAN - Canada Free Trade Agreement (ACAFTA), as follows:

In reference to the 7th ACAFTA TNC round in Kuala Lumpur on 25 February-01 March 2024, Working Group on Trade and Sustainable Development (WG-TSD) was agreed to be

established. The structure of the TSD chapter is subject to discussion by the working group.

The working group held its first meeting on July 30, 2024, which was primarily an introductory discussion. DTI-BITR as the lead agency for WG-TSD will coordinate accordingly once the working group begins substantive discussions.

BILATERAL

Philippine United Arab Emirates (PH-UAE CEPA)

PPS - PSD briefly discussed the updates on the ongoing PH — UAE CEPA negotiations which commences last May 14, 2024, with the 2nd round of negotiation concluded last July 8-10, 2024 in Manila.

The DENR is co - leading with DOLE the Trade and Sustainable Development (TSD) Chapter and providing technical support to the Trade in Services (TIS) Chapter **Environment** particularly on the related sector and subsector offers PH under the UAE CEPA. Considering that the TSD Chapter was proposed by the Philippines, the DENR drafted the environment provisions of the TSD Chapter.

PPS-PSD mentioned the forthcoming 3rd round Negotiation of the PH-UAE CEPA on September 16 - 18, 2024 in Dubai, UAE.

The PPS also discussed briefly the latest text of the TSD Chapter, particularly on the two items:

Preambular Statement:

LAS suggested changing the term "objective" to "goals" to be consistent with the 2030 Sustainable Agenda.

Trade Focal Group Members to updates on the PH – UAE CEPA.

Remaining members who are yet to provide comments and inputs on the latest TSD Chapter were reminded to submit the same untit September 2024. The said comments will form part of the Philippine position for the upcoming Round 3rd **Negotiations**

ERDB, EMB, FMB, CCS and BMB agreed.

Article XX.2.3 Scope

On item b., the ERDB suggested rephrasing into the management "of hazardous or toxic chemicals, substances, materials or wastes" or the dissemination of information related thereto. EMB agreed.

On item c., ERDB suggested to rephrase into "conservation and protection of protected areas particularly wild flora and fauna, including threatened species and their habitats" since it is broader and it includes various categories of threatened species.

LAS and ERDB agreed to retain the phrase "as well as protected areas" after the habitats.

Philippine -European Union Free Trade Agreement (PH -EU FTA) PPS - PSD provided a brief overview of the proposed Philippine - European Union Free Trade Agreement (PH - EU FTA).

The 1st round of negotiation will be held on 14-18 October 2024 in Brussels, Belgium.

In preparation for the 1st negotiating round, the DTI is requesting the DENR's confirmation to be part of the TWG on Trade and Sustainable Development Chapter together with DOLE (Labor) NEDA (Inclusivity); and on the TWG on Energy Raw Materials Chapter as technical support to DOE.

The EU also provided the zero-draft text of the proposed chapters.

The documents were forwarded to the respective Offices through a memorandum dated 15 August 2024.

Trade Focal Group Members were reminded to submit the following:

- 1. Nominate a representative/s to be included in the DENR Negotiating Team for the PH EU FTA. To date, the PPS PSD already received the nominations from CCS and ERDB; and
- Comments/inputs on the zero-draft text of the TSD and ERM Chapters. To date, please be informed that the PPS – PSD already received comments and inputs from FMB, ERDB and CCS.

A separate meeting will be conducted for a lineby-line discussion of the zero-draft text of the TSD
