INVITATION TO NOMINATE CANDIDATES FOR THE **MASTER IN CRISIS AND DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT** (MCDRM) PROGRAM BATCH 9 OFFERED BY THE PHILIPPINE PUBLIC SAFETY COLLEGE (PPSC)

This refers to the letter dated 05 August 2024 from the President of the Philippine Public Safety College (PPSC) extending the invitation for the Master in Crisis and Disaster Risk Management (MCDRM) Program Batch 9 Academic Year 2024-2025.

The MCDRM is a one-year scholarship program for highly qualified supervisors, managers, and senior executives in the government and private sectors, academe, industries, policy think tanks and senior officers in the public safety, disaster management and law enforcement services. The program aims to create a pool of crisis and disaster risk managers and leaders imbued with a deep understanding on the nature and challenges surrounding the unprecedented disruption happening in the country and the world and how they would navigate and execute their leadership and manage responsibilities strategically and effectively.

The PPSC shall cover the cost of tuition fee, seminar expense, land arrangements for the local field exposure activities, instructional materials, and expenses related to thesis completion (advising fee). On the other hand, the DENR shall shoulder the cost of the participant's travel and accommodation expenses during the face-to-face classes, local field study, international travel and related thesis requirements to complete the program, subject to the availability of funds and the existing policies, rules and regulations.

Interested applicants shall possess the following qualification requirements of the **DENR and the PPSC:**

- 1. Have at least two (2) years holding permanent plantilla position in the DENR at the time of application and five (5) years in the government service;
- 2. Must be 30-55 years old upon admission;
- 3. Have obtained performance ratings of at least Very Satisfactory for the last two (2) consecutive rating periods;
- 4. Performing duties and responsibilities relevant to the field of study/travel being applied for;
- 5. Have no pending administrative case;
- 6. Have no pending application and nomination for other study and non-study trips;
- 7. Have not exceeded four (4) official foreign travel within a year; MEMO NO. 2024 849

- 8. Have submitted all the required reports from previous foreign travels;
- 9. Have rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship previously enjoyed; and
- 10. Must be willing to sign a scholarship service contract and shall serve the DENR with the corresponding period of service obligation

The nominee shall submit the following requirements to Career Development Division on or before 23 September 2024:

- 1. Memorandum addressed to the Chair of the Human Resource Development Committee (HRDC), attention HRDC Secretariat to be concurred by the Secretary (for Undersecretary applicants) and Supervising Undersecretary (for Assistant Secretary and below applicants);
- 2. Resolution from HRDC Counterpart recommending the nomination of the applicant;
- 3. Service Record;
- 4. Certificate of no pending administrative case:
- 5. Certification from the Director supervising human resources/Assistant Regional Director for Management Service/Assistant Director (Region/Bureau/Attached Agency) stating that the applicant:
 - a. has no pending scholarship nomination;
 - b. has not been a delinquent scholar from a previous scholarship grant;
 - c. has submitted all the required reports from previous foreign travels;
 - d. has performance ratings of at least Very Satisfactory for the last two (2) consecutive rating periods;
- 6. Updated Personal Data Sheet, with Work Experience Sheet, duly signed by authorized person administering oath; and
- 7. Self Certification of official Travel History for the past 24 months
