In 2007, the CLOA was issued but there was no title number - Lot 72: The DAR stated that no CLOA would be issued for this land because it is considered public land and not covered by Zoleta's land.	Long-time occupants to submit letter to CENRO Catanauan requesting for a verification survey for lot 56 and lot 72. Status: Done on 21 October 2024

	However, in 2010, a Free Patent title was granted to someone not among the resident farmers. If this individual can get a Free Patent from DENR, why can't the DENR issue the same to long-time occupants	
5.	Brgy. Tagabas Ibaba, Catanauan, Quezon The area is already titled under the name of Gancayco Graciano	DENR suggested the farmers/occupants to vacate the area.
6.	Brgy. Cambuga, Mulanay It is crucial for the Office of the Solicitor General to refile the reversion proceedings as the land is timberland.	A composite team from DENR IVA is conducting an investigation and processing of documents to see if there are probable cause to refile for reversion.



Four farmers have been imprisoned: two for qualified theft and two for grave threats. The farmers' demand is the cancellation of the Free Patent.
