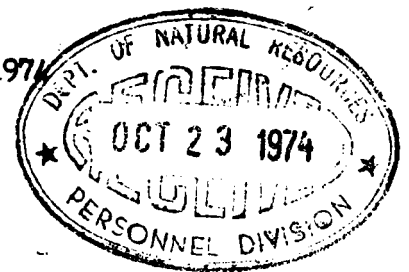

In view of the urgency of disposing the big backlog of verification of survey returns that has accumulated in the Mineral Lands and Topographic Survey Division, and to enable Mr. Restituto Ceria, Supervising Geodetic Engineer I, to have more time to attend to the supervision of the different technical phases of the Division's activities, Mr. Felipe Francisco, Chief Petroleum Geologist, is hereby temporarily assigned as Officer-in-Charge of the Mineral Lands and Topographic Survey Division, in addition to his regular duties without additional compensation.

In matters where there is a difference of opinion between the two, same shall be brought immediately to the attention of the Assistant Director for decision.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked.
