SUBJECT:

Organizing teams from the Bureau of Lands and the Bureau of Ferest Development for the purpose of relocating certain settlers end pasture lessees en the Island of Busuanga, Palawan.

In support of the proposed government development project in the Island of Busuanga, Palawan, a team each from the Bureau of Lands and from the Bureau of Forest Development are hereby organized to be composed of the fellowing personnel:

- The Bureau of Lands Team shall perform the fellowing functions and duties:
 - Prepare a scheme of subdivision over areas already classified as alienable and dispesable by the Bureau of Ferest Development where settlers which may be displaced from the government preject may be resettled;
 - Investigate land eccupancies and land claims not covered by Terrens Titles and lands covered by subsisting public land applications and recommend such action as may be warranted by actual findings in the premises;

- Evaluate actual and existing improvements of the small settlers within the project area for purposes of compensation;
- D. Allecate lets in the resettlement areas to the small settlers who may be displaced from the project area;
- Assist in the resettlement of the small settlers to the resettlement sites selected;
- F. Mediate in any dispute that may arise between the developer/ investor on one hand and the title helders or private ewners of preperties on the other hand within the project area;
- Goodinate field eperations with the BFD Teams
- III. The Bureau of Ferest Development Team shall perform the following functions and duties:
 - Provide the Bureau of Lands team with copies of land classification maps covering areas already classified as alienable and disposable within the Island of Busuanga;
 - B. Investigate areas covered by subsisting or proposed pasture leases in the project area and recommend such action as may be warranted by actual findings in the premises;
 - C. Select & Locate suitable areas which may be exchanged for the pasture areas within the project area for lessees who have subsisting pasture leases:
 - D. Relecate existing ranches to the pasture areas selected;
 - B. Evaluate actual and existing improvements of pasture lessees within the project area for purposes of compensation;
 - F. Assist in the relocation of the pasture lessees;
 - G. Coordinate field eperations with the BL Team.
- In clearing the project area of the small settlers & the pasture lessees who have cattle, and in resettling them to the new areas selected by the BL & BFD teams, portions of the project proposed to be developed first shall be cleared shead of the other portions.
- Any case which may arise and which may not be within the competence of the teams to resolve in the matter of evaluation of improvements shall be elevated for decision to the Director of Lands in the case of agricultural lands and to the Director of Ferest Development in the case of pasture lands.

- VI: The Bureau of Lands Survey Party organized by Region IV new operating on Busuanga Island shall execute the subdivision survey of all the agricultural and residential resettlement sites. The BFD Team shall prepare the maps of the pasture relocation sites.
- The agency heads concerned may increase the personnel of the teams in the area or make such medifications in the composition of the teams as they may deem necessary.
- VIII. All the members of the teams and the Survey Party shall return to their respective permanent stations upon completion of their respective work, in which event, a final report shall be submitted to this Office.
 - All eperating expenses incurred in connection herewith shall be berned by the agencies concerned.
 - X. All eperations and activities on the herein project shall be coordinated by Atty. Erneste C. Mendiela of this Office who shall organize a Staff to assist him in the performance of his duties as Project Coordinator. The field teams shall submit progress reports to the Project Coordinator regularly.
 - XI. This Order is for the good of the public service and shall take effect immediately.
