SUBJECT: Granting field teams to evaluate  
the performance of timber licenses  
and for other purposes.

1. Pursuant to Section 8 of FAD 64, series of 1972, and in line with the policy of the Bureau to conduct periodic evaluation on the performance of holders of timber licenses, leases, or permits, there is hereby constituted seven (7) field teams to undertake the work specified in the succeeding paragraphs, which teams shall be composed of the following:

2. The Committee created under Special Order No. 390, series of 1974, shall be empowered to assign the teams the timber licenses to be evaluated at a time in accordance with priorities it may deem appropriate to follow.

3. The teams shall, in their evaluation, consider, among other things, such factors as residual stand condition, logging equipment and machinery, road system, production efficiency, reforestation, forest protection and compliance with consolidation requirement, following the guidelines set forth in BFD Circular No. 13, series of 1974, which forms part of this Order as Annex "A".

4. The teams shall proceed to their assigned areas and complete their work within a reasonable time or as may be set by the Committee to enable them to submit their reports at the end of each month.

5. Regional Forestry Directors and District Foresters as well as all personnel concerned shall provide the teams with every assistance necessary towards the expeditious execution of the objectives of this Order.

6. All reports shall be submitted to the Committee created under Special Order No. 390, series of 1974, c/o Planning and Evaluation Division in quadruplicate copies, with the required supporting papers.

7. The teams are authorized to hire not more than three laborers for each team for surveying, brushing and such other purposes connected with or involved in the actual evaluation work.

8. Expenses incurred in pursuance of this Order shall be chargeable against the Special Deposits collected under FAD 64, above-cited, and traveling expenses shall be in accordance with GOA General Circular No. 127 dated November 27, 1973.

9. The Acting Director of the Bureau of Forest Development is hereby authorized to sign and/or approved the itineraries

and vouchers covering more than 30 days of the members of the evaluation teams so created under this Order.

10. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until the full completion of the purpose hereof or unless sooner revoked.
