
2. Each personnel shall be assigned a specific area of coverage consisting of one or more provinces or regions. In this connection, the above personnel are further authorized to hire any available means of transportation in order to accelerate the data collection and validation process, subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

3. All expenses incurred as a consequence of this Order are hereby authorized in accordance with COA Circular No. 127 chargeable against the appropriation of the Office of the Secretary.

4. A report of inspection shall be submitted to the NEPC Ad Interim Secretariat Executive Director, DNR, Diliman, Quezon City by the Personnel concerned within three days after their return.

5. This Special Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced until revoked in writing.
