## Functions of the Regional Monitoring Officer:

- Assist and closely coordinate with the Planning and Management Staff of the Bureau of Mines in the formulation and development of Regional Plans and Strategies.
- 2. Assist and coordinate planning in the bureau and regional level with the end in view of determining overall developmental strategies for the mining sector.
- 3. Coordinate with the Regional Development
  Council and other government agencies
  located within the region specially with
  the Bureaus under the Department regarding
  programs and projects.
- 4. Monitor closely the activities of the private mining sector within the region with the objective of gathering up-to-date mining production and other relevant data.
- 5. Investigate and assess in coordination with the Mines Regional Office damages caused by ecological backlashes and provide the Secretary with immediate feedback.
- 6. Coordinate closely with the Inter-Agency Committee on Environmental Protection (IACEP) and the Environmental Control Section of the Bureau of Mines on the monitoring of degraded areas and their rejuvination.
