SUBJECT:

Creating a Committee to Study the Most Appropriate Investment Structure for the Establishment of a Mine-Tailings Disposal System for the Baguio Mining District

In the interest of the Service, there is hereby created a Committee which shall conduct a comprehensive investment structure study for the establishment of an integrated mine-tailings disposal system for the Baguio Mining District composed of the following personnel:

As such, the following functions, duties and responsibilities shall be exercised and discharged by the Committee:

- Conduct financial capability studies of mining companies located within the Baguio Mining District which shall include solvency and liquidity profiles.
- 2. Coordinate with concerned government and private agencies/entities in the

conduct and implementation of the required studies.

- 3. Conceptualize and design alternative investment structure mechanisms as well as its advantages and disadvantages.
- 4. Recommend to the Executive Officer of the NEPC, the most appropriate investment structure which shall facilitate the immediate installation of a minetailings disposal system.

Travels which maybe required by the Committee in the discharge of its functions shall be on official time and authority is hereby given for the payment/reimbursement of transportation expenses incurred subject to the availability of funds and the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. In addition, representation expenses actually incurred may be reimbursed pursuant to Section 9 of P.D. 1121 (honoraria for existing personnel).

This Order shall take effect immediately and all Orders/Memoranda or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are automatically revoked and/or amended accordingly.
