

2. Duration of Survey

The Task Force and the Field Survey Teams shall conduct field surveys each of which will last for a maximum of fifteen (15) days. This is so because the areas to be surveyed are very far from major municipalities and islands and are not regularly plied by commercial sea transport, therefore, is time, energy, and money-consuming. It will also be done to avoid repetition of trips to the same area as all the work and observations necessary will be done in one field survey.

3. The members of the Task Force and the Field Survey Teams shall be entitled to P100.00 per meeting honorarium as may be authorized under existing regulations on the matter in connection with the above functions chargeable to the Special Activities Funds of this Office.
4. This Order shall take effect immediately and continue to be in force until revoked in writing.
