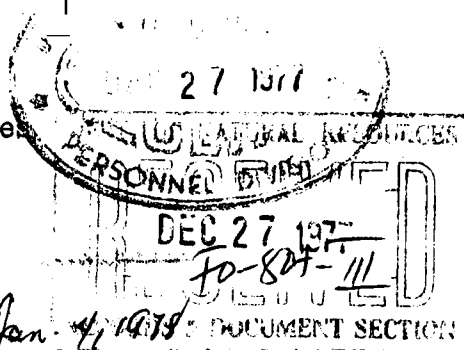
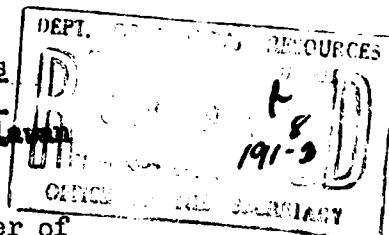

2. As Deputy Forest Officers, they shall perform the duties and functions defined in Section 2 of the above-stated Department Order. When in the performance of such duties, they shall be under the supervision of the District Forester, in whose district their area of jurisdiction is situated.

3. They shall immediately report to the District Forester concerned for instruction on their specific areas of responsibility and for such other matters as are deemed pertinent to this deputation order.

4. This Order shall remain valid during their tenure as Barangay Officials unless sooner terminated or revoked.

5. This Order takes effect immediately.
