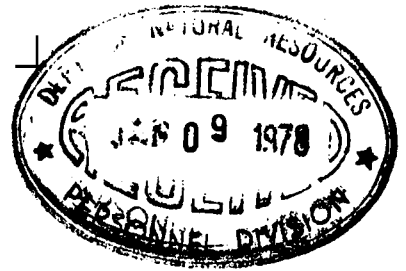




3. They shall immediately report to the District Forester concerned for instruction on their specific areas of responsibility and for such other matters as are deemed pertinent to this deputation order.
