SPECIAL ORDER
NO. 76
Series of 1977

SUBJECT: Authorizing a maximum of two (2) representatives for each member agency and the member of the Secretariat of the Inter-Agency Committee on Environmental Protection (IACEP) to collect ₱100.00 as per diem for every meeting or conference of the IACEP attended

Pursuant to Letter of Instruction No. 422 dated July 6, 1976, a maximum of two (2) representatives for each member agency and members of the IACEP Secretariat are hereby authorized to collect the amount of ONE HUNDRED PESOS (₱100.00) each as per diem for every meeting or conference held by IACEP, effective, January 1, 1977. Provided however, that remunerations to this effect shall not exceed THREE HUNDRED PESOS (₱300.00) per month and/or three (3) meetings monthly for each representative. Provided finally, that the effectivity of this Special Order shall remain enforced up to June 30, 1977.
