FURTHER DEFINING THE RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITY OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, FIDC

In the interest of the service and in view of the appointment of the Executive Director for the Fishery Industry Development Council effective February 1, 1977, the FIDC is hereby defined as a DNR-attached agency and technically and administratively excluded from the DNR special projects, except for general appropriations purposes. As such, the FIDC Executive Director has full technical and administrative supervision, control and responsibility over FIDC projects, personnel and monetary transaction, under general supervision of the FIDC Chairman and Secretary of Natural Resources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

In accordance with this Order, the FIDC Executive Director hereby assumes, for FIDC projects and activities, all signing authorities delegated to the Action Officer for DNR Special Projects and Activities per General Memorandum Order No. 5, Series of 1976, dated August 24, 1976, including travel orders, leaves of absence, meal, transportation and other allowances, payrolls, RIV's in amounts not exceeding ₱5,000, etc.

A monthly report concerning the exercise of this delegated authority shall be submitted to the FIDC Chairman through the undersigned every 15th and 30th of the month. Such report shall contain a list of actions taken or a brief summary or justification of such actions.

This Order shall take effect April 1, 1977 and revokes all orders inconsistent therewith.
