Creation of a Study Team to Undertake Field Studies on the Biology of "Ludong" in Cagayan Valley

In order to formulate and implement proper management, conservation and to ensure continued propagation of "Ludong", a study team is hereby created to be composed of the following personnel:

The functions/work plan on the study of the Biology of Ludong in Cagayan Valley are enumerated as follows:

- 1. Identify the sites where Ludong originate and trace its migration path during its different life stages.
- 2. Determine the exact taxonomic identification of Ludong and the various species occuring in Cagayan River.
- 3. Determine the production, volume of the different mullet species by established site.
- 4. Determine the potential by species for culture based on the volume of occurence and frequency.
- 5. Determine propagation methods on the mullets (Ludong).
- 6. Explore artificial possibility of spawning.

Report on the study conducted shall be submitted by the said team to this Office immediately upon return from the field.

The above-mentioned personnel are authorized to collect travel expenses incurred in the accomplishment of the objectives of the study, chargeable against the appropriation of that bureau/agency, subject to the usual accounting and auditing requirements.

This order shall take effect immediately.
