5. All expenses incurred as a consequence of this order are hereby authorized in accordance with COA Circular No. 127 chargeable against the appropriation of the MNR PCFEM funds.
6. A report of the evaluation shall be submitted to the Minister ten (10) days after their return to the Central Office.
