The Bureau of Lands is hereby designated to manage the ministry's participation in coordination with MNR officials and as such shall make the necessary preparations and coordination relative to the tournament.

The participation of MNR officials and employees in the tournament shall be on official time. They shall also be entitled to free uniforms and daily allowances of \$\mathbb{P}35.00\$ during the practice sessions and actual games provided that the practice sessions shall not exceed (3) times a week, chargeable against the respective funds of their respective offices save the officials and players from the Office of the Minister, MNR, who may collect the same from the Bureau of Lands, subject to the usual accounting and auditing requirements.

This order shall take effect immediately and is automatically revoked upon termination of the tournament.
