SUBJECT : Amending Special Order No. 107, Series of 1979 which Creates the Rattan Study Committee.

1. In the interest of the service and in order to implement more effectively MNR Administrative Order No. 5, Series of 1980: The Regulations Governing the Cutting, Transporting and Utilization of Rattan, the membership of the Rattan Study Committee is amended as follows:

2. The Committee will continue to have the following functions:

- a. Assess the rattan situation of the country including its economic, social & ecological dimensions;
- b. Serve as a forum for the members of the private sector interested in rattan to air their views and present problems;
- c. Submit recommendations/policy guidelines for the management of rattan resources; and
- d. Undertake studies on rattan & such other functions as directed by the Minister of Natural Resources

3. The Committee is hereby authorized to call on BFD, FORI, PCWID & other Ministry personnel to assist in the exercise of the afore-cited functions.

4. The members of the Rattan Study Committee are also hereby authorized to collect transportation allowance and per diems, chargeable to the funds of the Ministry of Natural Resources, in connection with the performance of their functions, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

5. All orders, circulars and/or memoranda inconsistent herewith are hereby revoked, amend or modified accordingly.

6. This order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing by the Minister of Natural Resources.
