SUBJECT:

Authorizing the NRMC to Host a Remote Sensing Workshop from 21-25 November, 1981 at the Hyatt Regency

As the Ministry's Center of multidisciplinary remote sensing activities in the Philippines, and as the lead agency in hosting a number of remote sensing workshops and conferences, the NRMC is hereby authorized to host a Remote Sensing Workshop, with particular reference to CCOP activities, (including Coastal and Offshore Surveys and SEATAR Programme) from 21-25 November, 1981 at the Hyatt Regency, to review what can and cannot be expected from remote sensing methods in connection with mineral prospecting and related activities in offshore and adjacent oceanic areas. Topics such as shallow coastal water survey from remote sensing imagery, SEASAT performance and the need for oceanographic satellite in the future and lineament analysis related to mineralization along SEASAT shall be considered.

NRMC participants and support staff selected by the Director General are hereby authorized to attend the Workshop on official time.

Expenses to be incurred in the conduct of the Workshop shall be limited to a maximum of \$\mathbb{P}\$120,000.00, chargeable against NRMC funds, subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
