- 2. Investigation of the economic status of operation and the present marketing system being followed in each ice and cold storage plant.
- 3. Develop a comprehensive scheme for the leasing/ turn-over of the ice and cold storage plants to cooperatives and other interested parties.
- 4. Closely monitor the progress of the Project and provide the Minister with relevant reports and recommendations concerning the Project.

All expenses that may be incurred as a consequence of this Order shall be charged against the appropriations of the respective agencies, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. All Orders inconsistent with this Order are hereby revoked and/or modified accordingly.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
