**SUBJECT: Creation of an Inter-Agency Study Team
to Undertake a Detailed Assessment of
the MNR-BFAR Cold Chain Project**

In view of the Ministry's concern to ensure efficient and effective management and operation of its Cold Chain Project; and in order that a systematic scheme for leasing/turn-over of ice and cold storage plants to fishermen cooperatives and other interested parties be formulated, an inter-agency team to undertake surveys, investigation and analysis of the existing system of operation of the above project is hereby created.

The above are at the moment, the priority ice and cold storage plants to be studied. Additional plants may be identified later and included in the team's activities.


Specifically, the team shall undertake the following:

1. Overall assessment of the individual ice and cold storage plants of the Cold Chain Project whether operating or still under construction/installation.
2. Investigation of the economic status of operation and the present marketing system being followed in each ice and cold storage plant.
3. Develop a comprehensive scheme for the leasing/turn-over of the ice and cold storage plants to cooperatives and other interested parties.
4. Closely monitor the progress of the Project and provide the Minister with relevant reports and recommendations concerning the Project.

All expenses that may be incurred as a consequence of this Order shall be charged against the appropriations of the respective agencies, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.


All Orders inconsistent with this Order are hereby
