1. 
2. The teams created herein shall provide guidance to the BFD Regional Offices concerned in the gathering and collation of the various resources data and information essential in the formulation of the master tree plantation development plan.

3. They shall, upon receipt of this Order, report immediately to the Assistant Secretary for Policy and Scientific Research, Ministry of Natural Resources, for further instructions, after which proceed to their respective areas of assignment and report to the Regional Director concerned.

4. Expenses incurred in connection herewith shall be charged against the funds of the Offices/Units concerned, subject to existing accounting and auditing regulations.

5. The teams shall submit their reports, together with the desired data and information, direct to the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Policy and Scientific Research, MNR within seven (7) days from the termination of the field work.
