The provision of the PITCEM as regards the member-agencies composing the SCNRE and its functions is hereby retained as follows:



Functions

1. To plan Philippine participation in ESCAP meetings, seminars, etc., involving the ESCAP Work Programme: evaluation, development, use and management of energy, mineral and water resources in the Region.
2. To prepare appropriate position papers for ESCAP Meetings on natural resources.
3. To review the nomination of participants and the level of representation to the meetings.
4. To review and analyze reports of meetings and seminars, with emphasis on policy implications arising out of such conferences.
5. To monitor relevant developments that can be inputted to the planning and review processes of the Sub-Committee, in particular, and of the government, in general.
6. To monitor the implementation of ESCAP Projects in the Philippines.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked, amended or modified in writing.
