SUBJECT : CREATION OF A SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO EVALUATE BFAR ICE PLANTS, COLD STORAGE FACILITIES AND THE PIER FACILITIES APPURTENANT THERETO.

1. There is hereby created a Special Committee and, under it, Sub-Committees on Field Inventory, Legal Matters, and Budgetary Matters, to evaluate ice plants, cold storage facilities, and the pier facilities appurtenant thereto, which are hereby constituted as follows:

- 2. The Special Committee, through the Sub-Committees under it, shall have the following functions:
 - To make an inventory of all existing ice plants, cold storage facilities, and the pier facilities appurtenant thereto, including asset valuation of the same.

- b) Formulate the budgetary requirements, administrative functions, and the operationalization of such ice plants, cold storage facilities and the pier facilities appurtenant thereto, including programs, and staffing patterns; and
- c) Submit a report, with specific recommendations, to the Minister of Natural Resources within three (3) months from the date of this Special Order.
- 3. In the performance/discharge of their functions and duties, the committee members shall be entitled to such honoraria/extra services pay as may hereafter be determined, chargeable against the funds of the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources.
 - 4. This Order takes effect immediately.
