SUBJECT : Creation of a Program Advisory Committee
for the SEAFDEC's Aquaculture Department

In the interest of the service and in line with the implementation of the country's Integrated Fisheries Development Plan (IFDP), a SEAFDEC Aquaculture Department (AQD) Program Advisory Committee is hereby created to help formulate the Department's program directions for 1982 and provide advices to the Minister of Natural Resources in the review and recommendations of the AQD's budget releases in accordance with the Special Provision of the General Appropriations Act for 1982 under the Batas Pambansa Blng. 131.

To carry out the above-mentioned objectives, the Program Advisory Committee will be composed of the Minister of Natural Resources as Chairman, Deputy Minister Arnold B. Caoili as Vice-Chairman and the following as members.

In addition to the above, one representative each from the Ministries of the Budget and Foreign Affairs, Private Sector and the Academe, shall be named as members.

The MNR Planning Service, with the assistance of FIDC and BFAR technical staff shall provide Secretariat to the Committee.

Furthermore the said Committee shall formulate recommendations with the necessary directions for 1983-1984 for the AQD based on the new policies, thrusts, and in accordance with the National Budget Circular No. 352 and Circular Letter No. 81-10.

Recommended Program Directions for 1982 shall be submitted on or before February 15, 1982 while Program recommendations for CY 1983-1984 and appropriate documents shall be submitted in accordance with the budget calendar provided under Circular Letter No. 81-10.

The members of the committee, secretariat and consultants are authorized to collect expenses including honorarium in the performance of their functions subject to usual accounting rules and regulations.

Funds needed for these activities are chargeable against the appropriation of the OMIN and BFAR.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
