SPECIAL ORDER NO. 128 Series of 1983

SUBJECT: Creation of MNR-NRDC Resource Enterprise
Management Program

In the interest of the service and in line with Executive Order No. 786 for MNR and NRDC to promote investment in natural resources based industries, and the government's policy of conservation, renewal and optimum utilization of natural resources, the MNR-NRDC Resources Enterprise Management Program is hereby created with the following guidelines.

1.0 Objectives

1.1 General

To promote investment in natural resources based industries.

- 1.2 Specific
 - 1.2.1 To develop and implement support activities to the Pig-Iron Plant and Stumpage Sale System Projects to attain the objectives therein.
 - 1.2.2 To formulate, develop and initiate resource based activities in support to the countryside development, environmental management and industrial development.
- 2.0 Resources Enterprise Management Staff
 - 2.1 A Resource Enterprise Management Staff (REMS) is hereby created under the NRDC-Corporate Planning and Development Group (CPDG). Among others, REMS shall develop and coordinate the implementation of the different components of the Program.

3.0 Institutional Arrangements

- 3.1 MNR shall provide financial and manpower support to the Program.
- 3.2 NRDC shall implement the Program components and shall administer the funds provided thereof by MNR.

4.0 Funding and Support

Funds needed to implement the Program shall be chargeable to MNR-OMIN PPA No. 1.1.2 (Forest Industries Food Production Program), No. 1.1.5 (National Council for Forest Ecosystem Management), No. 1.1.6 (Integrated Approach to the Development of Philippine Inland Waters), No. 1.1.16 (Management of Special Projects), No. 1.1.20 (Natural Resources Investment Promotion Program) and from other PPAs of OMIN, Bureaus, and attached agencies as may be directed by the Minister.

All offices and units are hereby directed to provide support services and resources to the Program.

This Order takes effect immediately and revokes all other orders inconsistent herewith.
