SUBJECT: Activation of the Agrarian Reform
Unit under the Office of the Minister

- 1. In the interest of the service, and in order to maximize efficiency and effectiveness in the accomplishment of its assigned tasks, the Agrarian Reform Unit is hereby activated. As a coordinating Unit of the Ministry of Natural Resources with that of the Ministry of Agrarian Reform on matters regarding land surveys and development, release of lands of the public domain for settlement/ re-settlement purposes, and other related activities, it is also tasked to perform the following specific functions:
 - a. Provide the Office of the Minister with advice and assistance in coordinating the work of the MNR with that of the Ministry of Agrarian Reform.
 - b. Maintain close coordination and harmonious work relationship with the Bureaus under the MNR and other government agencies whose functions relate to agrarian reform matters.
 - c. Monitor the activities and accomplishments of the different Committees (NRSRC, ICCAR, IECPAR, NCC-FAO/ASSARD) and other special projects which are financially supported by the MNR and where the Unit is actively involved in.
 - d. Consult the Planning Service, MNR in the preparation and formulation of its policy guideline in order to effect a viable implementation of the agrarian, land, and forestry programs.

- Incorporate in its organizational and functional set up the objectives laid down in the Letters of Instructions signed by the President on July 28, 1982 (LOI Nos. 1258, 1260, and 1262) regarding socio-economic development.
- In view thereof, all personnel under the Agrarian Reform Unit who are presently detailed in the different Offices in the Ministry are hereby recalled and are instructed to report to Mr. ROGELIO C. DAQUER, Head, Agrarian Reform Unit, for purposes of giving specific assignments and effective administrative supervision and control.
- This order takes effect immediately and rescinds or revokes or cancels previous orders inconsistent herewith.
