SUBJECT: Creation of a Task Force on BFAR Ice
Plant and Cold Storage Facilities



2. The Task Force, through the sub-committees under it, shall have the following functions:
- a) Conduct physical inventory of all IPCS facilities, including asset valuation of the same
 - b) Facilitate and monitor the completion of IPCS currently under construction, repair and rehabilitation
 - c) Recruit or select and train personnel who will handle operation and management of the plants
 - d) Provide an interim management for all IPCS and eventually formulate or evaluate management options
 - e) Submit regular reports to the Minister of Natural Resources on the progress of the transfer and subsequent operations of the plants.
3. The field inventory expenses for the first and second quarters of CY 1983 will be shared by the Ministry of Natural Resources, BFAR and PFDA as follows:

5. The Task Force shall temporarily hold office at the BFAR Engineering Office, BENLOR Bldg., Quezon Avenue, Quezon City.
