Table Tennis.	Prisciliano L. Nazal (OMIN) Alfredo Nava (BFD)


The above designated officials shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

1. Make all the required preparation such as:
 - a) Selection of players/organization of their respective team and submission of selected players for the issuance of the corresponding special order.
 - b) Coordinate/attend meetings of the IDEAL Sub-committee.
 - c) Manage and supervise their respective team during the practice session and actual tournament.
 - d) Submit official reports on the result and conduct of their participation in the IDEAL Tournament.

As such, these designated officials are authorized to conduct try-out and practice sessions on official time. Further, all heads of Bureaus/Offices are enjoined to allow aspiring athletes to participate in said try-out and practice sessions.

In this connection, and to enhance MNR participation in the IDEAL tournament all designated officials are entitled to free uniform. Likewise, they are also authorized to collect such necessary transportation expenses and reasonable allowances in accordance with MC 1258 chargeable against their respective Bureau/Office, Subject however to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

This order shall take effect immediately and compliance herewith is hereby enjoined.
