As such, the attendance of the above-named personnel in organizing, training, practice and actual games shall be on official time. They shall likewise be allowed to hold their practice games twice a week. Further, and as authorized by Memorandum Circular

No. 1258, Series of 1983, the same officials/employees shall be entitled to claim reimbursement for reasonable transportation expenses, daily allowances not exceeding \rlap/v 40.00 per practice and actual game, and other maintenance expenses, chargeable against their respective offices taken from any maintenance and other operating fund, subject to the availability of funds and the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

For this particular tournament, the cost of uniforms; towels shoes and socks of the MNR Junior Basketball Team members shall be shouldered by the Philippine Fish Development Authority (PFDA).

This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced until otherwise revoked.
