- C. Support personnel like clerk-typists, researchers, drivers, messengers, etc. shall be drawn from the PCWID Secretariat.
- D. Work Venue shall be the PCWID Conference Room.
- 2. This Working Group may call on any official or personnel of PCWID, BFD or MNR for any assistance or information needed to make the Feasibility Study a success.
- 3. As a counterpart of MNR to the Joint-Venture Program, the Group shall conduct dialogues with officers of MHS on matters outside the scope of MNR.
- 4. The Group shall submit to the Office of the Minister of MNR, the Feasibility Study on or before 10 July 1983 including the proper recommendations for the Joint-Venture Program.
- 5. They are authorized to undertake field works for purposes of the study as occasion demands.
- 6. They shall be entitled to honoraria and/or other expenses allowable under existing rules and regulations, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. However, reimbursements for trip expenses shall be charged to their respective agencies.
- 7. This Order shall take effect immediately.
