CREATION OF A COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT A
SEMINAR ON EFFECTIVE PROSECUTION OF
CRIMINAL CASES INVOLVING VIOLATIONS OF
FORESTRY LAWS, ETC. AND TO PREPARE A
PRIMER/HANDBOOK ON THE SUBJECT

In the interest of the service, a Committee is hereby created to conduct a seminar on effective prosecution of criminal cases involving violations of Forestry Laws and regulations, and to prepare a PRIMER/HANDBOOK on the subject for distribution to all forest officers.

All expenses, including allowances herein indicated, that will be incurred by the Committee in the performance of the above-functions shall be chargeable to the Bureau of Forest Development. The Chairman, Co-Chairman and members shall be entitled to a monthly allowance of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,000.00, \$\mathbb{P}\$800.00 and \$\mathbb{P}\$600.00, respectively.

All offices and agencies concerned under the Ministry of Natural Resources are enjoined to render all possible assistance and cooperation to the Committee.

The Committee is directed to finish the work not later than January, 1984.

This Order takes effect immediately.
