SUBJECT: Capiz Prawn Industry Development Study

In line with the Ministry's Special Order No. 261, Series of 1983 which provides for the accelerated development of the aquaculture industry in general and the prawn industry in particular, the **CAPIZ INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT STUDY** shall hereby be undertaken.

- 1.0 The study shall have the following objectives:
 - 1.1 To determine the technical feasibility as well as the economic viability of developing/accelerating prawn aquaculture in Capiz;
 - 1.2 To examine and provide baseline data on the socio-economic and environmental conditions of fishpond projects in Capiz Province;
 - 1.3 To determine the technical, marketing, management and financial factors affecting the performance of these fishpond projects;
 - 1.4 To recommend measures, policies and implementation strategies which may be deemed necessary for the development of the prawn industry in the province; and
 - 1.5 To identify possible local and foreign credit/financing schemes to support expanded prawn production and marketing activities.


The Project Team is authorized to coordinate with appropriate agencies at the central, regional and field levels.
