In response to President Marcos' call for self sufficiency and to exemplify the government's thrusts in harnessing our forest production capabilities, there is hereby created a special committee to establish an agro-forestry model farm on the open spaces within the MNR compound, along Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City, by planting forest trees, fruit bearing trees, marketable vegetables, rootcrops and other suitable plants.

The Committee shall insure that clearing, fencing, earthwork and all other necessary activities subsequent to planting should immediately be implemented.

Aside from the Committee's immediate task of planting forest trees, fruit trees and vegetables on the open spaces within the MNR compound, it shall draw up a master plan which may be the basis for replication in open spaces of other MNR agency compounds.
