
SPECIAL ORDER

SUBJECT: Operationalization of NRD-IV-24, Taytay, Palawan and NRD-IV-28, Quezon, Palawan; and designation of Messrs. Juan Galvero and Vicente Señorin as Acting District Land Officers thereof, respectively


1. In the interest of the service and to carry out further the purposes of Administrative Order No. 52 dated December 1, 1982, Natural Resources District (NRD)-IV-24 at Taytay and NRD-IV-28 at Quezon, both in Palawan, are hereby activated.
2. Hearing Officer I Juan G. Galvero is hereby relieved of his duties in NRD-IV-26, Puerto Princesa City, and is hereby designated as Acting District Land Officer of NRD-IV-24 with seat of district land office at Taytay, Palawan.
3. Administrative Assistant II Vicente F. Señorin is likewise hereby relieved of his duties in NRD-IV-26, Puerto Princesa City, and is hereby designated as Acting District Land Officer of NRD-IV-28, Quezon, Palawan.
4. By virtue of this Order, Messrs. Galvero and Señorin shall perform all the duties of a regularly-appointed District Land Officer in their respective districts: Provided, however, that before they sign patents covering areas not exceeding five (5) hectares, prior certification shall be submitted by them to the Regional Director, Region IV of the Bureau of Lands, that the office machinery of each of these newly-activated districts is now adequate for such district office concerned to prepare, process and issue patents, in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 6516.
5. The public land applications and other public land and survey records of landowners/applicants of the municipalities of Taytay, ~~Dumaran~~, ~~and El Nido~~, ~~and Araceli~~, all of Northern Palawan, which records are in the district land office at Roxas, Palawan, shall immediately be transferred to the district land office at Taytay, Palawan.
6. Similarly, the public land applications and other public land and survey records of landowners/applicants of the municipality of Quezon, Palawan, which records are in the district land office at Puerto Princesa City, shall immediately be transferred to the district land office at Quezon, Palawan.

7. The above-designated Acting District Land Officers shall recommend to the Regional Director, Region IV of the Bureau of Lands, the assignment of present personnel from other districts to, or the recruitment of new personnel for, their respective districts.
8. Messrs. Galvero and Señorin shall clear themselves of any property, money and records accountabilities in their respective present assignments before assuming their corresponding duties in their new stations; and shall immediately inform the Ministry in writing, thru the Regional Director of Regional Land Office IV and the Director of Lands, of the time and date the said newly-designated Acting District Land Officers assumed their respective new assignments by virtue of this Order.
9. This Order revokes Roxas, Palawan Acting District Land Officer Priscilla M. Sebido's concurrent jurisdiction over NRD-IV-24, Taytay, Palawan, and Narra, Palawan Acting District Land Officer Demetrio B. Aquino's concurrent jurisdiction over NRD-IV-28, Quezon, Palawan, respectively under subparagraphs 1.1 and 1.2, paragraph 1 of Ministry Special Order No. 363 dated August 15, 1983, as well as any provision of any previous Orders that may be inconsistent herewith, and takes effect immediately.
