Each member of the Technical Board shall be entitled to receive reimbursable transportation and representation allowance of $\slashed{P}1,000.00$ per month provided he/she attends at least one meeting per month and makes his/her services available to FIDC on a continuing basis, particularly on matters pertaining to his/her agency's areas of responsibility. Officially authorized/designated representatives of the Board members shall be entitled to receive reimbursable transportation and representation allowance of $\slashed{P}500.00$ each, subject to the foregoing conditions. Funds for this purpose shall be charged against FIDC fund according to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
