
SUBJECT: RECONSTITUTION OF THE FIDC

Each member of the Technical Board shall be entitled to receive reimbursable transportation and representation allowance of P1,000.00 per month provided he/she attends at least one meeting per month and makes his/her services available to FIDC on a continuing basis, particularly on matters pertaining to his/her agency's areas of responsibility. Officially authorized/ designated representatives of the Board members shall be entitled to receive reimbursable transportation and representation allowance of P500.00 each, subject to the foregoing conditions. Funds for this purpose shall be charged against FIDC fund according to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
