

nomical distance to the charcoal kiln and mobilize organized barangay residents in the area in the establishment of the same.

3. The Secretariat shall assist the Team in the over-all coordination and implementation of the program as well as to assist in the charcoal kiln construction and plantation establishments.
4. The Secretariat shall also prepare periodic report and submit the same to the Minister.
5. Funds for the plantation establishment and the construction of specifically assigned charcoal kiln shall be charged against the appropriation of the Bureau who is likewise directed to set funds thereof.
6. The said personnel shall be entitled to incentive allowances per month effective January, 1984 as follows:
