SUBJECT: Reassignment and Designation of Certain

- 1.7 Ricardo Elcarte - From District R7D-3, Dumaguete City, to Regional Office, Cebu City designated OIC as Chief, Program Development Section, Social Forestry Division.
- 1.8 Olivia M. Apa-ap - Timber Management Section designated OIC as Chief of Section
- 1.9 Rodulfo V. Aragon - Plans and Program Staff, Office of the Regional Director, designated OIC as Chief thereof, concurrently with his present designation as OIC, Forestry Extension and Education Services Section, Social Forestry Division.
