SPECIAL ORDER Series of 1984

SUBJECT: Establishment and Administration of the Butuan-Buenavista Agro-forestry and Multiple Livelihood Project as an Integrated Area Project under the Integrated Social Forestry Program in Region 10, Cagayan de Oro City.

- 1. In accordance with the provisions of MAO # 48, Series of 1982 and in order to operationalize the Integrated Area Project concept under the Integrated Social Forestry Program, the Butuan-Buenavista Agro-forestry and Multiple Livelihood Project is hereby established as an Integrated Area Project in Region 10. The administration is hereby likewise transferred from the NRMC to the BFD effective immediately.
 - The Project shall have the following objectives:
 - To generate livelihood opportunities among tural communities therein;
 - To reforest the barren and denuded areas of a portion of the public and alienable and disposable lands; and
 - To provide a form of security to forest occupants by issuing Stewardship Certificates.
- A Project Team shall be organized by the National Secretariat upon the recommendation of the BFD Regional Director, Region 10, which shall be responsible for the actual management and effective implementation of all project activities therein, particularly the various ISF program components defined in Sec. 9, MAO # 48. The Team shall be composed mainly of appropriate BFD personnel from the Regional and District offices supported

by personnel from other member agencies as indicated by LOI 1260. The Project Team shall be under the direct supervision of the BFD Regional Director.

- 4. Funds necessary for the implementation of this project shall be taken from the current appropriations of the BFD and from the Office of the Minister.
- 5. This Order supersedes MNR Special Order No. 85, dated 22 February 1982 and similar orders, circulars, and instructions inconsistent herewith.
- 6. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall be in force unless revoked in writing.
