The members of the Coordinating Body, Regional Implementation Teams and support groups as may be created are hereby authorized to claim compensation in lieu of overtime pay in accordance with COA Circular No. 78-77 dated February 28, 1978 subject to the availability of funds and the usual auditing regulations.

This order shall take effect January 1, 1985 and shall remain in force unless otherwise amended and/or repealed.
