SUBJECT: Launching for the Inter-Service/Office

The steering committee shall exercise general supervision over the operation of said tournaments and shall be the policy making body.

The sub-committee members shall be directly and fully responsible for the implementation of this program, such as on the control, proper conduct and right manner of maintaining order and the observance of the highest spirit of sportsmanship in the competition. Shall be responsible for compliance by their respective service/offices for their participation in the competition. The above members of the sub-committee may designate their alternates to assist them in the organization/formulation of their respective teams.

Make all the necessary preparation such as the designation of athletic director, manage/supervise the actual tournament and the formation of ground rules and regulations, scheduling of games, venue and referee.

As a joint undertaking the support and assistance of everyone is necessary to assure the total success of this activity. The attendance of officials and players during practice and actual events shall be on official time and may claim reasonable allowance subject however to the availability of funds.

This inter-service/office athletic competition may start right after the Holy Week on April 1985.

This order shall take effect immediately and compliance thereto is hereby enjoined.
