Manager of Land Survey and Titling
Component of the PALAWAN INTEGRATED
AREA DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

- 1. In the interest of the service and pursuant to the Special Order No. 42 (Series of 1982), former District Land Officer Mariano M. Villanueva is hereby re-designated as Asst. Project Manager of Land Survey and Titling Component of the Palawan Integrated Area Development Project.
- 2. Mariano M. Villanueva shall report directly to the Project Manager and shall perform the duties and functions of the Office of the Assistant Project Manager.
- 3. Assistant Project Manager shall have overall supervision of the project and shall be immeduately responsible for the:
 - a) Effective implementation of the plans and programs of the entire project, and the attainment of the planned work goals of the Land Surveys and Titling Sub-Component;
 - b) Preparation of the entire project's operation plans;
 - c) Supervision and coordination of the functions and activities of the land surveys and titling sub-component;
 - d) Assessment and evaluation of the performance of the entire project's various operating units;
 - e) Identification and resolution of problems and policy issues confronting the entire project's implementation;
 - f) Preparation and submission to the Project Manager, Regional Director, the Deputy Minister for Planning and Project Management and Minister of Natural Resources of periodic progress and status reports of the entire project;



- g) Administrative supervision over Contract surveyor's activities to ensure compliance with the contractual requirements;
- h) To sign patent not exceeding 5 hectares or 5,000 square meters in area where there is no official signing authority;
- i) Closer coordination with the other participating agencies;
- j) Perform other functions that may be assigned.
- 4. This Order shall take effect immediately and cancels/ supercedes all previous orders, memoranda and/or letters inconsistent herewith.
