SUBJECT: Creation of Working Group to evaluate road-rights-of-way in Fort Magsaysay Military Reservation, and to come up with relevant plans and programs on the matter

1. In the interest of the service, a Working Group is hereby created to evaluate land use with respect to road-rights-of-way of the Philippine Army within the Fort Magsaysay Military Reservation in Laur, Nueva Vizcaya, and to formulate relevant plans and programs with regard to this matter, pending the resumption of tree cutting/logging and transportation operations inside the reservation.


