SUBJECT: Creation of PBAC Secretariat for Foreign-Assisted Projects (PBAC-FAPs)

Pursuant to Special Order No. 104, series of 1987, there is hereby created a PBAC Secretariat for Foreign-Assisted Projects (PBAC-FAPs) of the Department to be composed of the following:

- 1. Ms. Dorothy Tadeo - Chairman
- 2. Mr. Rodrigo Fuentes
- 3. Mr. Rolando Cuano
- 4. Mr. Maximo Soriano, Jr.
- 5. Mr. Luis Eleazar

The Secretariat shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Serve as the administrative staff of the PBAC-FAPs and assist the same in the overall coordination of all its activities:
- Maintain complete record and document on the operation, resource and expenditure related to the execution of their task:
- Submit all pre-qualified list of prospective contractor/s and suppliers to the PBAC-FAPs for final review, evaluations and selection;
- 4. Prepare all the tendering activities up to the contract preparation and submit the same to the PBAC for approval;
- 5. Assist the PBAC in the preparation of evaluation and awards both international and domestic level;



6. Recommend to the PBAC the composition and functions of the Technical Sub-Committee which will evaluate the technical aspects of all submitted bids relating to infrastructure and non-infrastructure works being tendered.

This Order shall take effect immediately and all orders and/or memoranda inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
