> SUBJECT: Creation of a Steering Committee to Review/ Assess Foreign-Assisted Programs/Projects

In consonance with the overall review of mining policies, programs/projects, a Steering Committee is hereby created and tasked to perform the following functions:

- 1. To review the foreign-assisted projects of the Bureau of Mines & Geo-Sciences (BMG) in order to formulate standards of measurement for evaluation of results and to generate project proposals that will be equitable to the country and to the foreign donors.
- 2. To undertake the performance audit of all technical data gathered by all foreign-assisted projects.
- 3. To draw recommendations on projects that should be prioritized, resumed or abandoned.
- 4. To identify areas where aid can be sought from other countries to enhance completion of our mineral objectives.

Members of this committee shall be composed of consultants commissioned to conduct such review/assessment of mining policies, programs/projects per S.O. Nos. 147 and 170 and BMG staff who may be requested to provide assistance.

The members of the Steering Committee shall be entitled to the corresponding compensation as may be allowed under existing laws and regulations and shall be charged against the funds of the Bureau of Mines and Geo-Sciences subject to applicable accounting and auditing regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately.
