Assistant Secretary Ricardo M. Umali is hereby designated as Officer-in-Charge of all matters relating to national mapping and resource information management within the mandate of the Department. As such, he has the authority to do the following:

- 1. Review the current programs, manpower requirements, and equipment capability of all agencies attached to the Department related to national mapping and resource information management.
- 2. Serve as the Coordinating Officer to provide the smooth delivery of public services of the Natural Resources Management Center, National Cartography Authority, Bureau of Coast and Geodetic Surveys, and part of the Land Classification Staff/Teams of the Department during the period of transition towards their integration into the National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA) as mandated by Executive Order No. 131.
- 3. Recommend to the Secretary, through the Central Reorganization Committee, measures that may be undertaken to reorganize and realign all activities of relevant agencies in accordance with the policy directions of the Department.
- 4. Assist the Central Reorganization Committee in undertaking the tasks of reorganization pursuant to Executive Order No. 131.
- 5. To perform other tasks on national mapping and resource information management as assigned by the Secretary.
