SUBJECT

Assignment of Dr. Jose L. Diaz as Officerin-Charge of the RP-Japan Crocodile Farming Institute Project Site at Irawan, Puerto Princesa, Palawan

- 1. In the interest and exigency of the service, Dr. Jose L. Diaz is hereby assigned as Officer-in-Charge (OIC) of the RP-Japan Crocodile Farming Institute Project Site during the interim period prior to the implementation of the Department-wide reorganization.
- 2. As OIC of the Project Site Dr. Jose L. Diaz shall report directly to the undersigned.
- 3. In signing official correspondences, he shall sign as:

- 4. As Officer-in-Charge of the Project Site he shall have overall supervision of the project in the field level and shall be responsible for the:
 - a. Effective implementation of the plans and programs the project site;
 - b. Preparation of the project site operation plans in concurrence with the Undersecretary for Planning and Policy and in coordination with the Project Liaison Office of the DENR;
 - c. Identification and resolution of problems and policy issues confronting the project site implementation;
 - d. Preparation and submission to the Undersecretary for Planning and Policy and Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources of periodic progress and status reports of the project site;

- 5. As Officer-in-Charge of the Project site he is hereby given authority as follows:
 - To recommend the approval of travel orders of project personnel including their itinerary of travel, certificate of travel completed, and the corresponding vouchers for transportation fares and per diems.
 - b. To recommend the approval of payrolls and vouchers for payment of salaries, wages, and COLA of contractual and casual employees assigned to the project.
- 5. This order shall take effect immediately and cancels/ supercedes all previous orders, memoranda and/or letters inconsistent herewith.
